## **Reward Wall Systems® Introduces 11” Corner with H-Bracket**

*Tie production expansion creates opportunity for tie enhancements.*

Omaha, Neb., (May 6, 2008) -- Reward Wall Systems, Inc.® today announces the patent-pending corner bracket is available in the 11 inch 90-degree corner in the iForm® product line. The full-height, double-H bridging corner bracket, which was first introduced in the 13 inch 90-degree extended corner in July of 2007, has enhanced block performance by providing unmatched strength during concrete pours and the most corner attachment flexibility in the ICF industry.

“The addition of this corner to the iForm line means a stronger and more versatile product for our customers,” said John Moylan, vice president of sales and training.

In addition to corner updates, tie production has expanded to three new locations in Virginia, Colorado and Missouri. “Production at multiple plants will allow us to build redundancy into the system,” said Kevin Jones, vice president of manufacturing operations, “while allowing us to increase the efficiency of inventory maintenance.”

The diversification of Reward Wall Systems’ tie manufacturing created the opportunity to lengthen the furring strips on both the 9 and 15 inch iForm to extend the full length of the forms. Also, the composition of the tie will now consist of pellet-type first generation regrind and reprocessed material, rather than a first generation flake regrind product.

“Although our ties have historically performed quite effectively, this new pellet material will only serve to enhance the quality of the tie,” said Jones.
